

2010 Imports of Green Coffee into EU27 by main origin








Over 2,8 Mio tonnes of Green Coffee were imported into EU27 in 2010

Green Coffee Imports into EU27 (excl.intra-EU trade)


Top 5 suppliers - 2010




Belgium's role in International Coffee Trade



Belgium is an important point of entry for Green Coffee for other EU-countries


Green Coffee Imports into Belgium





Belgium is important transit-country of Coffee




Importance of Port of Antwerp

Antwerp is by far the most important Storage point of Green Coffee in the World!


Green Coffee Stocks in Major Coffee Ports



End of Year Raw Coffee Stock Positions in Port of Antwerp (1991 - 2010)






2. Connectivity: Maritime connections

Shortsea regional container traffic



- highest productivity in Europe: up to 40 moves/hour/crane





- Fast & efficient access to European roasters & markets



- Merely 40 km from Brussels, the European capital






Excellent hinterland connections by Barge


- Connected to the European waterway network by Scheldt-Rhine canal and Albert canal
- Over 175 container shuttles per week to 56 destinations in Europe
- 45 barge operators offer regular, even daily, services between Antwerp and the European hinterland

Excellent hinterland connections by Barge






=> 1997 – 2008: strong growth of inland navigation

Excellent hinterland connections by Rail


- Antwerp is located on a junction of international lines
- 1,055 km of railway tracks in the port
- Each terminal is connected to the railway network
- 250 loaded cargo trains daily
- 24 million tons transported per rail in 2009 (net)

- Highly skilled labour force


