Next five days:

Between this Friday and the weekend, weather conditions will begin to change over the producing areas of the center-south, when a cold front is expected to advance across the ocean, spreading instability over the producing areas of São Paulo and southern Minas Gerais. Rain will still be scattered between Saturday and Sunday and should not yet advance over the northernmost areas of the region, but should already begin to alleviate the heat.

Attention: Each data above is the accumulated rainfall in the last 24 hours, collected from official meteorological stations, at 12:00 GMT (9:00 am local time) of the day. That values are interpolated to a grid point format, and indicates the mean rainfall of each region.

Extended Forecast:

Rainfall is expected to be more significant at the beginning of next week. Especially between Monday the 24th and Tuesday the 25th, the rains tend to spread and occur in moderate volumes, especially in producing areas between São Paulo and south-central Minas Gerais. Until the end of the month, the rains tend to spread more sparsely to the northern areas of the Southeast and parts of Bahia.

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
