Next five days:

Throughout this Friday, there is a possibility of increased cloud cover in parts of the South of Minas Gerais and the Triângulo Mineiro region. The forecasted rains should be punctual, localized and of light intensity. Over the weekend, the weather will remain clear on Saturday and Sunday in the main coffee producing areas. However, from the turn of Sunday to Monday, a new cold front should advance over the region, bringing instability. Monday and Tuesday will be marked by rain in the South of Minas Gerais and the Triângulo Mineiro region, with expected accumulations of around 30 mm. These volumes may cause temporary interruptions in field activities, but, on the other hand, they will continue to contribute to maintaining soil moisture. Starting on Tuesday, instability will advance towards Espírito Santo, Bahia and the north of Minas Gerais. In these areas, isolated rain showers are expected, accompanied by gusts of wind and electrical discharges. This rain, although localized, should help alleviate, albeit modestly, the soil moisture deficit. Maximum temperatures over the weekend tend to be slightly high in the coffee-producing region, around 30°C. However, with increasing cloudiness at the beginning of next week, the maximum temperature should drop to around 27°C.

Attention: Each data above is the accumulated rainfall in the last 24 hours, collected from official meteorological stations, at 12:00 GMT (9:00 am local time) of the day.
That values are interpolated to a grid point format, and indicates the mean rainfall of each region.

Extended Forecast:

Next week, coffee-producing areas are expected to start with cloudy weather and occasional showers. The rains are expected to persist until Wednesday, with clearer weather expected to improve from the middle of the week. The most significant accumulations are expected to occur on Monday, mainly over the South of Minas Gerais and the Triângulo Mineiro region. In Espírito Santo and Bahia, the most significant rainfall volumes are expected to be concentrated between Tuesday and Wednesday. In the second half of the week, temperatures are expected to drop gradually. The arrival of a cold air mass is expected to cause a drop in minimum temperatures, especially in the South of Minas Gerais, starting next weekend. Minimum temperatures are expected to reach values around 13°C. So far, there is no expectation of frost.

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
