Attention: Each data above is the accumulated rainfall in the last 24 hours, collected from official meteorological stations, at 12:00 GMT (9:00 am local time) of the day.
That values are interpolated to a grid point format, and indicates the mean rainfall of each region.

Extended Forecast:

A new change in the weather is forecast for early next week, when a new cold front is expected to advance along the Brazilian coast. However, this system is expected to cause more coastal instability over the Southeast, and for now, significant rainfall is not expected in coffee-producing areas.

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
