Next five days:

This Wednesday, the advance of a cold front across the ocean is expected to favor isolated rain showers over the coffee-producing region of southern Minas Gerais. These instabilities will be mild and unlikely to cause major disruptions to field activities, but they will contribute to a slight reduction in maximum temperatures. Temperatures in the region are expected to reach around 27°C. In the Triângulo Mineiro region, the weather remains dry, with temperatures rising. Maximum temperatures are expected to reach approximately 33°C, increasing the risk of wildfires. In the producing areas of southern Bahia and northern Espírito Santo, rainfall is expected to be localized and light. Although it does not pose a significant risk to agricultural activities, it helps maintain a milder climate. In the second half of the week, the weather will return to being stable in much of the coffee-producing regions, with a tendency for a gradual rise in temperatures.

Extended Forecast:

The weekend will be marked by stable weather in coffee-producing areas, with temperatures gradually rising throughout the week. In southern Minas Gerais and the Triângulo Mineiro region, highs are expected to reach around 30°C. In Bahia and northern Espírito Santo, the rain will ease over the course of the day, giving way to clear skies and more stable weather over the weekend.
