Next five days:

On Friday, the heaviest rain moves towards the north-central portion of Minas Gerais, where instability intensifies. In Espírito Santo, a rainy day is expected, with volumes between 30 and 40 mm. In southern Minas Gerais and the Triângulo Mineiro region, showers continue, with accumulations around 15 to 20 mm. The weekend should be marked by predominantly dry weather in the coffee-producing areas. Isolated showers are forecast, but with low accumulations, around 5 mm. Temperatures tend to rise gradually in the producing region, with highs near 27°C. In Espírito Santo, Saturday will still be marked by instability and rain. From Sunday onwards, the weather will become clearer again, a condition that should remain at the beginning of next week, with predominantly dry weather.

Attention: Each data above is the accumulated rainfall in the last 24 hours, collected from official meteorological stations, at 12:00 GMT (9:00 am local time) of the day. That values are interpolated to a grid point format, and indicates the mean rainfall of each region.

Extended Forecast:

The start of next week should be marked by stable weather over the coffee-producing areas; no rain is expected in the region, and dry weather will prevail. From Thursday onwards, rain will gradually return, with the possibility of accumulations around 15mm over southern Minas Gerais and the Triângulo Mineiro region.
