Next five days:

Between Friday and Saturday, dry weather will continue to prevail, and conditions will remain favorable for coffee harvesting activities. The temperature range will remain greater, with still cold mornings and milder afternoon temperatures. Between the end of Saturday and Sunday, a more intense and organized cold front is expected to advance through the Central-South of Brazil, again affecting the state of São Paulo. Rain is expected to be more significant and widespread over the south-central region of São Paulo. Isolated, brief events with lower accumulations are expected to reach the Alta Mogiana region.

Attention: Each data above is the accumulated rainfall in the last 24 hours, collected from official meteorological stations, at 12:00 GMT (9:00 am local time) of the day.
That values are interpolated to a grid point format, and indicates the mean rainfall of each region.

Extended Forecast:

At the beginning of next week, starting on Monday the 13th, the system should move through the interior of the Southeast region, spreading rain in the form of isolated showers with moderate volumes over coffee-growing areas of São Paulo, Minas Gerais, and Rio de Janeiro. During the week, the system should also favor the intensification of rainfall over Espírito Santo and Bahia. After the system passes, temperatures will decline in the south-central region of the country, but no extreme temperatures are expected, posing a risk of damage to coffee plantations.

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
