Next five days:

Between this Friday and the weekend, dry weather will intensify over the coffee-producing areas of inland Brazil. Instabilities will be more persistent and should cause more significant rainfall between the far north of Espírito Santo and southern Bahia. At the beginning of next week, the rains tend to spread, in the form of isolated showers, over most of the state of Espírito Santo, while dry weather will continue to predominate in the other coffee-growing areas until the middle of next week. Temperatures will remain lower in the coming mornings over the Southeast, but no extreme cold is expected. Throughout next week, the heat tends to increase significantly during the afternoons over inland areas of the Southeast.

Extended Forecast:

In the second half of next week, a new change in the weather is expected, with a new system advancing and bringing rain to São Paulo, parts of Minas Gerais, and the eastern strip of the Southeast region. This system will be accompanied by another sharp drop in temperature, which for now does not indicate a risk of frost.

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
