 NEXT 5 DAYS ANALYSIS

Dry weather will continue to dominate the interior of Brazil and most coffee-producing areas in the coming days. This condition favors periods of sunshine, high temperatures, and stable weather, benefiting harvesting and drying activities of the beans. On the other hand, the persistence of heat and low humidity tends to intensify hydric and thermal stress in the crops. From this Friday through the weekend, the activity of an ocean system will again increase instability along the eastern belt of the Southeast region. Moderate intensity showers are forecast, especially on Saturday, between Zona da Mata in Minas Gerais and southern Espírito Santo. Between Sunday and early next week, rains should spread through Espírito Santo and also reach southern Bahia, with moderate intensity showers.

 EXTENDED FORECAST ANALYSIS

Next week, showers are expected to continue occurring as isolated showers, mainly in northern Espírito Santo and southern Bahia. In other coffee-producing areas of the country's interior, dry and hot weather will persist, maintaining favorable conditions for field activities but requiring attention to the increased hydric and thermal stress on the crops.
