 NEXT 5 DAYS ANALYSIS

Dry weather is expected to continue prevailing over most coffee-producing areas in the coming days. The combination of intense heat and low humidity further reduces soil moisture and increases thermal stress on the crops, potentially impacting flowering. The expectation is that dry conditions will persist until the weekend. Between today and Sunday, a cold front should move along the Southeast coast, causing rain mainly in the eastern strip of the region. Initially, precipitation is not expected to reach the main coffee-producing areas. This scenario is expected to change at the beginning of next week. Between Monday and Wednesday, rain is likely to intensify and spread over much of the coffee-producing areas of São Paulo, southern Minas Gerais, and the Zona da Mata region, as well as other areas in the eastern Southeast.

 EXTENDED FORECAST ANALYSIS

In the second half of next week, instability is expected to decrease and cooler weather will become prominent. Forecasts indicate a more significant drop in temperatures inland Southeast. In coffee-producing areas, minimum temperatures should reach between 8°C and 9°C in the colder areas between São Paulo and southern Minas Gerais, but currently, no extreme cold is forecast.
