 **NEXT 5 DAYS ANALYSIS**

The passage of a cold front along the coast between the South and Southeast regions spreads significant instability over coffee-producing areas in the coming days, especially in the state of São Paulo and the southernmost areas of Minas Gerais. Starting this Thursday, rainfall intensifies over the coffee areas between São Paulo and the extreme south of Minas Gerais. Some producing areas in the Alta Mogiana region of São Paulo and southern Minas Gerais may record volumes exceeding 30mm. In the Triângulo and Cerrado regions of Minas Gerais, rains occur more locally and with lower volumes. Between Friday and Saturday, unstable weather conditions persist over São Paulo, southern Minas Gerais, and the Zona da Mata region of Minas Gerais. In other coffee-producing areas of the Southeast, chances of rainfall are lower. With the persistence of instability in the southern parts of the region, temperatures are expected to be somewhat milder over the next few days.

 **EXTENDED FORECAST ANALYSIS**

The upcoming week will begin with highly unstable weather in the southern coffee-producing areas of the Southeast region. São Paulo and southern Minas Gerais are expected to experience heavy rains on Monday. Throughout the rest of the week, instability will continue to act, but more sporadically and with lower accumulated volumes. Nevertheless, the forecast indicates substantial

humidity and cooler temperatures between São Paulo and central-southern Minas Gerais. These conditions may cause interruptions to field operations but contribute to maintaining higher levels of available soil moisture. In the northern areas of Minas Gerais, Espírito Santo, and Bahia, weather tends to stabilize with clearer skies and warmer temperatures.
