📅 NEXT 5 DAYS ANALYSIS

The influence of a cold front between the Southern Region and São Paulo continues to favor the formation of instabilities this Friday, especially over the southernmost coffee-growing areas of São Paulo, where precipitation volumes may range between 20 and 30 millimeters. In other coffee-producing areas, the conditions for rainfall are lower, but the weather remains characterized by considerable humidity and cloudiness, particularly between the São Paulo interior and southern Minas Gerais. Over the weekend, the likelihood of rain increases between the São Paulo interior and Minas Gerais. The highest volumes are still expected in southern São Paulo, where some locations may register around 30 millimeters. Isolated precipitation events may also occur in the Alta Mogiana Paulista, southern Triângulo and Zona da Mata regions of Minas Gerais, as well as areas of Espírito Santo. The persistence of humidity and unstable weather should limit temperature increases in the São Paulo interior. Conversely, in the northern parts of the state and the interior of Minas Gerais, many cities may record maximum temperatures above 30 °C between the weekend and early next week.

📅 EXTENDED FORECAST ANALYSIS

Next week, rainfall is expected to intensify and spread across most coffee-producing areas of the Southeast. The highest volumes are forecast for Monday, mainly in São Paulo, including the Alta Mogiana, where some locations may receive accumulations exceeding 30 millimeters. Between Monday and Tuesday, moderate intensity rains should also occur in the Zona da Mata and southern Minas Gerais. Starting midweek, precipitation is expected to decrease in São Paulo and the southernmost areas of Minas Gerais. During this period, the most intense instabilities are likely to advance into Espírito Santo, as well as eastern and northern Minas Gerais. Throughout the next week, occasional rain episodes are also anticipated over coffee-producing areas in Bahia.
